Protecting your private information is our priority. D LEE ENTERPRISES LLC's privacy policy (the "Privacy Policy") is to make you aware of our policies and procedures regarding the collection and safeguard of data provided by you to us as you use or engage with the Site and our Services.

For the purposes of this Agreement, the terms "we," "us," and "our" refer to D LEE ENTERPRISES LLC (the "Company"). The www.iamdeborahlee.com website hereafter is referred to as the "Site." The terms "user," "you," and "your" refer to site visitors, customers, and any and all other users of the Site.

This Privacy Policy applies to the Site, Company's mobile applications, Company's other websites, Company's emails, texts, or other electronic correspondence between you and the Company. This Privacy Policy governs any and all data submissions by user and Company's data collection, maintenance, protection, usage, and disclosure for all of our Services that are available on or through the Site, and other users' websites that use the Services, while you are logged into your account with us or using the Site. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to the Company include www.iamdeborahlee.com. By using the Site, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Read this policy carefully to understand our use, policies, practices, and treatment of your Personal Information and Non-Personal Information. If you do not wish to agree to the terms and conditions of this Site and this Privacy Policy, you must not access or use this Site.

Children Under the Age of 18

The Site and the Services provided by us are not directed to anyone under the age of 18. D LEE ENTERPRISES LLC does not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from children under the age of 18. If you are under the age of 18, you must ask your parent or guardian for permission to use the Site. In the event that we learn that we have gathered personal information from anyone under the age of 18 without the consent of a parent or guardian, we will delete that information as soon as possible. Coverage of the Policy

We provide personal development coaching and Christian coaching groups, services, subscriptions, and consulting (the "Services"). The Services include but are not limited to individual and couples coaching, life coaching, group membership and coaching services, apparel, home goods, digital resources, books in any format, masterclasses, on-demand teaching video resources, and anything else provided by D LEE ENTERPRISES LLC and its subsidiaries, partners, and affiliates.

Collection of your Personal Information

In order to better provide you with the Services offered, the Company may collect "Non-Personal Information" and "Personal Information." **Non-Personal Information** includes but is not limited to, information that cannot be used to personally identify you, such as anonymous usage data, general demographic information we may collect, referring/exit pages and URLs, platform types, preferences you submit and preferences that are generated based on the data you submit and number of clicks. **Personal Information** includes but is not limited to, your email address, full name, mailing address, billing address, phone number, and credit card information, which you submit to us through the registration or purchase process at the Site. If you purchase our Services, we collect billing and credit card information. This information is used to complete the purchase transaction.

We do not collect any personal information about you unless you voluntarily provide it to us. However, you may be required to provide certain personal information to us when you elect to use our Services. These may include but are not limited to: (a) registering for an account; (b) entering a contest sponsored by us or one of our partners; (c) signing up for special offers including special offers from selected third parties; (d) sending us an email message; (e) submitting your credit card or other payment information when ordering and purchasing our Services. We also may gather additional Personal or Non-personal Information in the future.

Automatically Collected Information

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by Company. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times, and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Site.

Tracking User Behavior

Company may keep track of the Site and pages our users visit within Company, in order to determine what Services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within Company to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

Use of Cookies and Pixels

The Site may use “cookies” to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize Site pages, or register for our Services, a cookie helps the Company recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the Site, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the Site’s features that you customized.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. Comments and Other User Communication

You may provide information to be posted, published, or displayed on the Site, or transmitted to other users of the Site or third parties (“User Communication”). Any and all User Communication transmitted to others is at your own risk. User acknowledges and agrees that we cannot control the actions of other users of the Site with whom you may choose to share your User Communication. Use of your Personal Information

The Company collects and uses your Personal Information to present and make available the Site and its contents to you, operate and deliver the Services you have requested, provide you with information related to the Company's offers for products, subscriptions, and services, execute any contract between you and the Company, and administer all of Company's other legal business activities.

The Company may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of offers of services and products available from Company's affiliates (the "Affiliate") whereas Company may receive commission by the Affiliate to be paid by such Affiliate. Upon your acceptance of the Affiliate offer, a third party will receive your information.

Sharing Information with Third Parties

Company does not sell, rent, trade, lease or otherwise share Personal Information to third parties without your consent.

Company may share data with its affiliates, subsidiaries, successors in interest, or trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these Services to Company, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your Personal Information. Your Personal Information will generally be used to contact you.

Company may disclose your Personal Information, without notice, if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) comply with a federal, state, or local statute or comply with legal process served on Company or the Site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of Company; and/or (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of Company or the public.

In general, we use Non-Personal Information to help us improve our Services and customize the user experience. We also aggregate Non-Personal Information in order to track trends and analyze use patterns on the Site. This Privacy Policy does not limit in any way our use or disclosure of Non-Personal Information and we reserve the right to use and disclose such Non-Personal Information to our partners, advertisers and other third parties at our discretion.

In the event we undergo a business transaction such as a merger or acquisition by another company, or sale of all or a portion of our assets, your Personal Information may be among the assets transferred. You acknowledge and consent that such transfers may occur and are permitted by this Privacy Policy, and that any acquirer of our assets may continue to process your Personal Information as set forth in this Privacy Policy. If our information practices change at any time in the future, we will post the policy changes to the Site so that you may opt out of the new information practices. We suggest that you check the Site periodically if you are concerned about how your information is used.

Security of your Personal Information

Company employs commercially reasonable efforts to secure your personal information from unauthorized access, use, or disclosure. Company strives to implement adequate security measures to protect against unauthorized access, use, alteration, and disclosure of your Personal Information. All information provided by you is stored according to Wix.com's data storage policy on Wix.com's data

storage databases and applications, which are located on secure servers behind a firewall. Furthermore, your payment transactions will be encrypted and safely transmitted using Wix Payments which complies with the Payment Card Industry Data Security Standards (PCI DSS) and using commercially reasonable efforts.

- Exercise free speech, ensure the right of another consumer to exercise his or her right of free speech, or exercise another right provided for by law;
- Comply with the California Electronic Communications Privacy Act;
- Engage in public or peer-reviewed scientific, historical, or statistical research in the public interest that adheres to all other applicable ethics and privacy laws, when our deletion of the information is likely to render impossible or seriously impair the achievement of such research, provided we have obtained your informed consent;
- Enable solely internal uses that are reasonably aligned with your expectations based on your relationship with the Company;
- Comply with an existing legal obligation; or
- Otherwise use your personal information, internally, in a lawful manner that is compatible with the context in which you provided the information.
